Participant and Parent/Guardian, please review the PIBCSS Code of Conduct and sign and date below.

- 1. Be respectful.
- 2. Listen to and follow all directions.
- 3. Disruptive, disrespectful, and/or reckless behavior will not be tolerated and you may be asked to sit out of class or be removed from the class entirely if a problem persists. If disruptive, disrespectful, or reckless behavior persists, you may be expelled from the program for the remainder of the season without a refund.
- 4. Respect others and their property. This includes fellow students and their belongings, instructors, island pools, the PIBYC, and all surrounding areas.
- 5. Pick up after yourself and throw away all trash. Leave your area in better shape than how you found it.
- 6. Take care of all equipment loaned to you. Swimming and sailing gear needs to be put away neatly and properly in its designated place. Boats should be cared for properly, per instructors' directives.
- 7. Remain in designated areas during class time. Sailors should not sail beyond boundaries set by instructors at the beginning of each class. Swimmers should not swim in areas considered out-of-bounds or off-limits by their instructors.
- 8. Come to class with appropriate gear and a good attitude, ready to participate fully.

I understand and have discussed these responsibilities and policies with my child. We understand that failure to follow these rules may result in dismissal from the Swim/Sail Program without any refund. Further, if a student's willful or reckless activity, as determined by the Swim/Sail Board, causes damage to property, equipment, or boats, the cost of repair or replacement will be at the expense of the student's parents or guardians.
